Dogs




Holidays during term time

Celebrate your birthday with a book!




Holden Clough no longer celebrates birthdays with sweets or cakes. Instead, we ask that children and parents choose a book to donate to their classroom library.




We thank you for your support in helping us adopt this new policy, we hope that the children will embrace our birthday book scheme and will enjoy leaving a literary legacy in their classroom.

...on a school place for your child



If your child will be 4 before 1 September 2024

YOU should put your child's name down at any Tameside Primary School.

DURING October the school will send you the information you will need to make your application.

IF your child attends a school nursery this will not secure them a place in Reception. You will need to make a new application for a Reception place.

YOU must apply for a Primary School Reception place online through the Tameside Council website at www.tameside.gov.uk

THE online application facility will open for new Reception. applications early November 2023.

THE closing date for Primary School applications is 15 January 2024

ANY application received after 15 January 2024 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.

YOU should apply for a High School place through the local authority where you live. EXTRA district residents will receive information on how to apply from their own local authority. YOU must apply for a High School Year 7 place online through. the Tameside Council website www.tameside.gov.uk THE online application facility will open for new Year 7 applications early September 2023. THE closing date for High School applications is 31 October 2023. ANY application received after 31 October 2023 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.
