### Is Your Child Eligible for Free School Meals / Pupil Premium?

Did you know that School can claim additional funds from central Government for **every** child in **any** year group whose Parent/Carer is receiving one of the welfare benefits listed below?

- Universal Credit, provided they have an annual net earned income not exceeding £7,400(£616.67 per month)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by HMRC
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

The additional funds are put towards valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching and pupil welfare. If eligible, your child will also have the option of enjoying a Free School Meal every day.

So if you are in receipt of any of the benefits listed above we would be very grateful if you could complete the online form at <a href="https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims-tameside">www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims-tameside</a> and check your eligibility.

### Administering Medicine in School

Should your child be prescribed any medication or antibiotics that need to administered during the school day, please bring the medication to the school office where it will be stored securely and complete a request to administer medication form. For the safety of all, please do not send any medication in to school with your child.



### **Nut Free School**

We have a number of children in school who have a severe allergy to all types of nuts where a reaction can occur not only by consuming them but also by just being in the vicinity of nuts or products that contain nuts. Therefore, we would like to remind you not to send any snacks, cakes etc. into school that contain nuts of any type.

# Reporting Absence

If your child is absent from school please ensure you report their absence to the school office as soon as possible on the **first day and each day thereafter detailing the reason for their absence**.

### Please do not use Class Dojo to report an absence.

Any unreported absences will be recorded as UNAUTHORISED until an acceptable reason for the absence is provided. We are only able to authorise 3 days leave due to illness without medical evidence. Any child that has attendance below 90% will be required to provide evidence to prove their absence. This could be medication, appointment letter/text or photographic evidence.

# Holidays in Term Time

Parents must not book holidays during term time, no matter the reason. We appreciate that this affects prices etc. but we must ask that school attendance is a priority. We have unfortunately already refered families to the court service for fines.

Weddings, parental appointments and work commitments will not be authorised and school will action the local authority's policy for absence fully. It is important that you follow the school policy on reporting sickness, and we would also ask you not to tell us your child is sick if they are on holiday - Just be honest with us about your intent.

Work your child misses when they are off is hard to catch up and while fully appreciating the benefits of travel for wider learning, we ask you to use the 175 days available to you annually when your child is not required to be in school, to enrich your child's cultural and academic horizons.

Please work with us to ensure that your child has every opportunity to take advantage of the fantastic education available at Holden Clough. It has been hard since COVID to restore the attendance balance at school so help us to show your child how important this aspect of learning is.
