

Museum of Transport



As part of their History learning: "How has transport changed over time?" 1DH will be going to Manchester Museum of Transport on Wednesday 14th May.

The Museum's focus is the history of road passenger transport in Greater Manchester and there are over seventy buses and other vehicles on display. It is a 'working' museum, with as many vehicles as possible maintained in full working order. This helps give the Museum the atmosphere of a bus garage of bygone years, lending a realistic setting to the vehicles themselves. Maintenance and restoration is undertaken by the Museum's volunteers.

Manchester Museum
