Reporting Absence


If your child is absent from school please ensure you report their absence to the school office as soon as possible on the first day and each day thereafter detailing the reason for their absence.



...on a school place for your child



If your child will be 4 before 1 September 2022

- You should put your child's name down at any Tameside Primary School.
- During October the school will send you the information you will need to make your application.
- If your child attends a school nursery this will not secure them a place in Reception. You will need to make a new application for a Reception place.
- You must apply for a Primary School Reception place online through the Tameside Council website at <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u>
- The online application facility will open for new Reception applications early November 2021.
- The closing date for Primary School applications is 15 January 2022.
- Any application received after 15 January 2022 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.

High School

If your child will be 11 before 1 September 2022

- You should apply for a High School place through the local authority where you live.
- Extra district residents will receive information on how to apply from their own local authority.
- You must apply for a High School Year 7 place online through the Tameside Council website at <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u>
- The online application facility will open for new Year 7 applications early September 2021.
- The closing date for High School applications is 31 October 2021.
- Any application received after 31 October 2021 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.
