## Year 6 Maritime Museum Trip

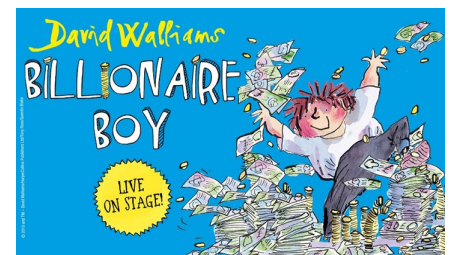
Year 6 will be going to the Maritime Museum at the Albert Dock in Liverpool, on Wednesday 9th February.

## Changes to Isolation Periods

The isolation period is still 10 days but can be reduced to **5 full days** (as long as your child is well enough and without a temperature) and receives **2 consecutive negative** LFD results which were **taken 24 hours apart**. The earliest they should take the first LFD test is on day 5.

Any **positive test** after a first **negative test** would mean that the first negative is **null and void**. Your child would still require 2 consecutive negative tests from this point forward. You must register results with the NHS Website [here](#) and you must send the confirmation from the NHS for both these results to school [attendance@holdenclough.tameside.sch.uk](mailto:attendance@holdenclough.tameside.sch.uk). You can order a pack of LFD tests [here](#).

**TO RETURN ON THE DAY OF A SECOND NEGATIVE TEST, BOTH TESTS WOULD NEED TO BE TAKEN BEFORE 9AM.**

Day Zero is the day symptoms started **or** the day the test was taken if asymptomatic. Day 1 of isolation is the day after Day Zero.

**In any scenario, the isolation period can only end if your child no longer has a high temperature.** This applies even if they have tested negative twice. If children still have a high temperature after Day 10, they should stay off school and seek medical advice such as contacting your GP or phoning 111.
