



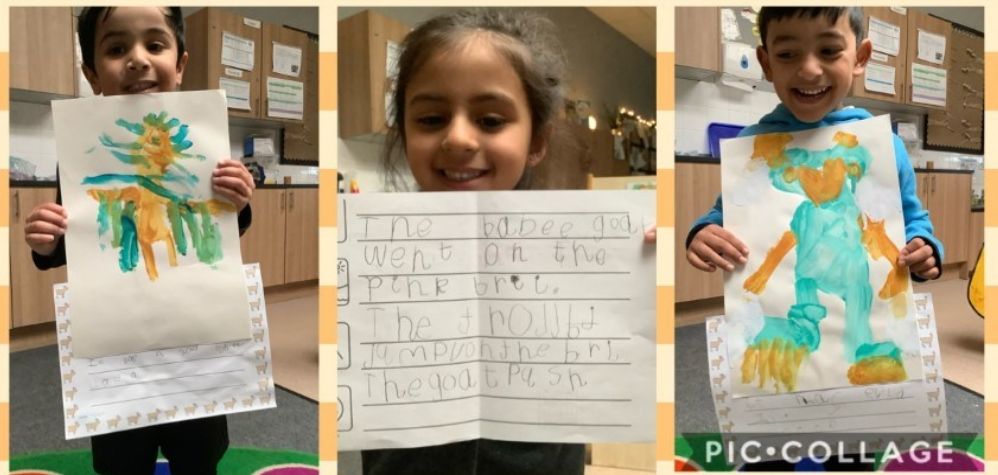

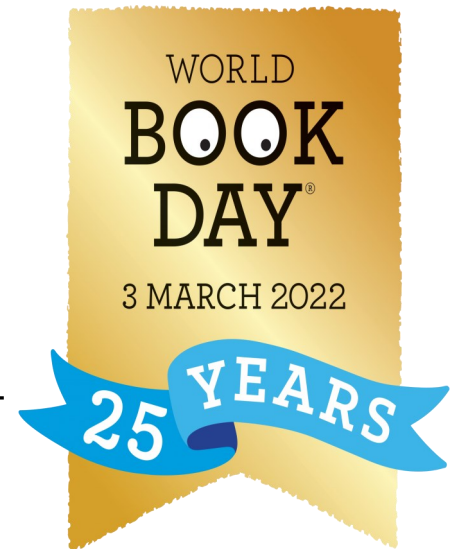

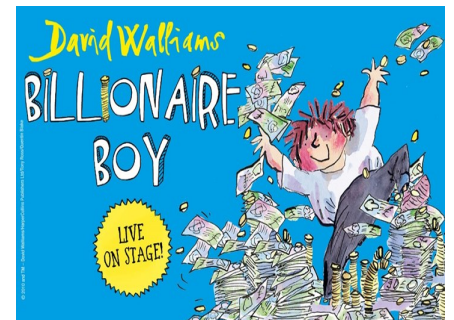
## World Book Day 2022

## Billionaire Boy at the Palace Theatre

All children in Key Stage 2 will be going to the Palace Theatre in Manchester on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022 to see the live West End production of Billionaire Boy by David Walliams.



We will be leaving school at 9.30am and we will be back before the end of the school day. If your child will be having a packed lunch from school, please credit the School Meal area of your ParentPay account with £2.40 for the price of a school meal unless your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Free School Meals.

Children will also need to wear their full school uniform.

The cost of the tickets for this trip to the Palace Theatre including coach travel is £15.00 per child to be paid by ParentPay by 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022.
